

(o) Parole and probation employees assigned by the Director of Parole and Probation to supervise offenders under Article 41, § 4-602A of the Code have the same powers of arrest for these offenders as are set forth in this section for police officers.

(p) A police officer may arrest a person without a warrant if:

(1) The police officer has probable cause to believe a stalking under § 124 of this article has been committed;

(2) The police officer has reason to believe that the alleged stalking victim or a third person is in danger of imminent bodily harm or death; and

(3) The probable cause under paragraph (1) of this subsection is supported by credible evidence other than statements of the alleged stalking victim.

(q) Correctional officers designated by the Commissioner of Correction under § 684A of this article have the same powers of arrest for individuals on the property of a facility under the jurisdiction of the Division of Correction as are set forth in this section for police officers.

(r) Correctional officers designated by the head administrative officer of a county or municipal correctional facility under § 684B of this article have the same powers of arrest for individuals on the property of the facility as are set forth in this section for police officers.
