

- (i) Curriculum guides;
- (ii) Courses of study;
- (iii) Resource materials;
- (iv) Textbooks;
- (v) Supplementary readers;
- (vi) Materials of instruction;
- (vii) Visual and auditory aids;
- (viii) Supplies;
- (ix) Teacher performance; and
- (x) Other teaching aids.

(4) Based on their review, the Council shall recommend and advocate improvements to the educational programs at correctional institutions.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1999.
