## AN ACT concerning

# Vehicle Laws - Failure to Stop at Red Light - Points

FOR the purpose of increasing, under certain circumstances, the number of points required to be assessed by the Motor Vehicle Administration against an individual convicted of failing to stop a vehicle as directed by a traffic control signal displaying a steady red light; making conforming changes; and generally relating to the assessment of points for red light violations.
