- (f) Before taking office, each appointee to the Board shall take the oath required by Article I, § 9 of the State Constitution.
  - (g) (1) The term of a member is 4 years.
- (2) The terms of the members of the Board are staggered as required by the terms of the members of the Board serving on July 1, 1988.
- (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
  - (4) A member may not serve more than 2 consecutive full terms.
- (5) To the extent practicable, the Governor shall fill any vacancy on the Board within 60 days of the date of the vacancy.
- (h) (1) The Governor may remove a member for incompetency, misconduct, or neglect of duty.
- (2) Upon the recommendation of the Secretary, the Governor may remove a member whom the Secretary finds to have been absent from 2 successive Board meetings without adequate reason.

## 17-205.

- (a) In addition to the powers set forth elsewhere in this title, the Board may adopt rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of this title.
  - (b) In addition to the duties set forth elsewhere in this title, the Board shall:
    - (1) Maintain a registry of all COUNSELORS OR THERAPISTS currently[:
      - (i) Certified professional counselors;
- (ii) Certified professional counselors-marriage and family therapists;
  - (iii) Certified professional counselors-alcohol and drug;
  - (iv) Certified associate counselors-alcohol and drug; and
- (v) Certified supervised counselors-alcohol and drug;] LICENSED OR CERTIFIED BY THE BOARD;
  - (2) Submit an annual report to the Governor and the Secretary;
- (3) Adopt a code of ethics that the Board considers to be appropriate and applicable to [certified professional counselors, certified professional counselors—marriage and family therapists, certified professional counselors—alcohol and drug, certified associate counselors—alcohol and drug, and certified supervised counselors—alcohol and drug;] THE COUNSELORS OR THERAPISTS CURRENTLY CERTIFIED OR LICENSED BY THE BOARD;
- (4) Establish continuing education requirements for [certified professional counselors, certified professional counselors-marriage and family
