- (1) The name, title, business address, and business telephone number of the professional counselor OR THERAPIST performing the services;
- (2) The formal professional education of the professional counselor OR THERAPIST, including the institutions attended and the degrees received from them;
- (3) The areas of specialization of the professional counselor OR THERAPIST and the services provided;
- (4) In the case of a person certified under this subtitle OR LICENSED UNDER SUBTITLE 3A OF THIS TITLE who is engaged in a private individual practice, partnership, or group practice, the person's fee schedule listed by type of service or hourly rate;
- (5) At the bottom of the first page of the disclosure statement, the words, "This information is required by the Board of Examiners of Professional Counselors which regulates all [certified professional counselors and certified professional counselor-marriage and family therapists"] CERTIFIED AND LICENSED COUNSELORS AND THERAPISTS"; and
- (6) Immediately beneath the statement required by item (5) of this subsection, the name, address, and telephone number of the Board.

Subject to the hearing provisions of § 17–314 of this subtitle, the Board, on the affirmative vote of a majority of its members then serving, may deny a certificate to any applicant, PLACE ANY CERTIFICATE HOLDER ON PROBATION, reprimand any certificate holder, or suspend or revoke a certificate of any certificate holder if the applicant or certificate holder:

- (1) Fraudulently or deceptively obtains or attempts to obtain a certificate for the applicant or certificate holder or for another;
 - (2) Is addicted to any narcotic or is habitually intoxicated;
- (3) Aids or abets an unauthorized person in practicing professional counseling or representing to be a certified professional counselor;
 - (4) Violates the code of ethics adopted by the Board;
 - (5) Knowingly violates any provision of this title;
- (6) Is convicted of or pleads guilty or nolo contendere to a felony or a crime involving moral turpitude, whether or not any appeal or other proceeding is pending to have the conviction or plea set aside;
 - (7) Is professionally, physically, or mentally incompetent;
 - (8) Submits a false statement to collect a fee;
 - (9) Violates any rule or regulation adopted by the Board;
