

(F) THE APPLICANT FOR AN INITIAL LICENSE SHALL COMPLETE ~~2,000 HOURS~~ OF PRACTICAL WORK EXPERIENCE THAT IS APPROVED BY THE BOARD AND THAT:

(1) IS OBTAINED OVER A PERIOD OF:

(I) ~~NOT LESS THAN 1 YEAR; NOT MORE THAN 3 YEARS;~~ AND

(II) ~~NOT MORE THAN 3 YEARS;~~

1. NOT LESS THAN 6 MONTHS IF THE APPLICANT APPLIES BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2000; OR

2. NOT LESS THAN 1 YEAR IF THE APPLICANT APPLIES ON OR AFTER OCTOBER 1, 2000;

(2) INCLUDES PROVIDING ANY TYPE OF SERVICE OR ADVICE INVOLVING THE USE OF ACCOUNTING, ATTEST, MANAGEMENT ADVISORY, FINANCIAL ADVISORY, TAX, OR CONSULTING SKILLS;

(3) IS PERFORMED UNDER THE DIRECTION OF:

(I) A LICENSED CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT; OR

(II) AN APPROPRIATELY QUALIFIED PROFESSIONAL AS DETERMINED BY THE BOARD; ~~AND~~

(4) IS OBTAINED THROUGH EMPLOYMENT IN GOVERNMENT, INDUSTRY, ACADEMIA, OR PUBLIC PRACTICE-; AND

(5) AMOUNTS TO:

(I) 1,000 HOURS IF THE APPLICANT APPLIES BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2000; OR

(II) 2,000 HOURS IF THE APPLICANT APPLIES ON OR AFTER OCTOBER 1, 2000.
