- (H) "FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 7-101(H) OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE.
- (III) "HOSPICE FACILITY" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 19–901(C) OF THE HEALTH—CENERAL ARTICLE.
