

(3) Characterized by a functional impairment that substantially interferes with or limits the child's role or functioning in the family, school, or community activities.

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**CHAPTER 447**

**(House Bill 706)**

AN ACT concerning

**Department of Agriculture - Soil Conservation and Water Quality Plans -  
Use of Information**

FOR the purpose of requiring the supervisors of a soil conservation district to provide the Maryland Department of Agriculture and the Department of the Environment with any information in a soil conservation and water quality plan for certain purposes; authorizing the Department of Agriculture to use the information for statistical purposes and to release the information to ~~a certain government agency~~ the Department of the Environment for a ~~law~~ certain compliance or enforcement purpose; requiring the Department of Agriculture and the supervisors to maintain plan information in a manner that protects the identity of the person for whom the plan was prepared; and generally relating to information concerning soil conservation and water quality plans.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Agriculture**

8-306.

(B) (1) THE SUPERVISOR SHALL MAINTAIN INFORMATION FROM A SOIL CONSERVATION AND WATER QUALITY PLAN IN A MANNER THAT PROTECTS THE IDENTITY OF THE PERSON FOR WHOM THE PLAN IS PREPARED. HOWEVER, THE SUPERVISORS SHALL MAKE A SOIL CONSERVATION AND WATER QUALITY PLAN AVAILABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT FOR ENFORCEMENT
