Prince George's County - Alcoholic Beverages - Pub-Brewery <u>and</u> <u>Micro-Brewery</u> Licenses

FOR the purpose of including Prince George's County among those jurisdictions in which pub-brewery beer licenses may be issued by the Office of the Comptroller; altering a certain limitation on the persons who may obtain a Class 7 micro-brewery license in Prince George's County; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Prince George's County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- (a) A Class 6 pub-brewery license shall be issued:
 - (1) By the State Comptroller;
- (2) Only to a holder of a Class B beer, wine and liquor (on-sale) license that is issued for use on the premises of a restaurant located in the jurisdictions permitted by this subsection;
 - (3) Throughout the State, but not in the following subdivisions:
 - (i) Allegany County;
