

(3) In counties or municipalities that have adopted the standard building code as of October 1, 1993, the Standards shall apply to all buildings and structures for which a building permit application is received by the local jurisdiction on or after August 1, [1999] 2001.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1999.

**CHAPTER 482**

**(House Bill 1044)**

AN ACT concerning

**State Employee Benefits Program - State Employees' Health Insurance Advisory Council**

FOR the purpose of increasing the membership of the State Employees' Health Insurance Advisory Council; and generally relating to the State Employees' Health Insurance Advisory Council.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - State Personnel and Pensions**

2-505.

(b) The Advisory Council consists of the following [15] 18 members:

- (1) the Secretary or a designee of the Secretary;
- (2) a representative of each of the following, appointed by the Governor:
  - (i) the Department of Budget and Management;
  - (ii) the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene;
  - (iii) the University System of Maryland Administration;
  - (iv) the Department of Transportation;
  - (v) the Insurance Commissioner;
