- (3) three in 2002;
- (4) two in 2003; and
- (5) two in 2004.
- (1) five in 2000;
- (2) four in 2001; and
- (3) four in 2002.

<u>SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED</u>, That for fiscal year 2001, the <u>Governor may include in the budget bill an appropriation to the Joseph Fund equal to the lesser of:</u>

- (i) 40% of the unappropriated surplus as of June 30, 1999; or
- (ii) \$10,000,000.

SECTION $\frac{2}{2}$. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1999.

CHAPTER 518

(Senate Bill 15)

AN ACT concerning

Teachers' Retirement and Pension Systems - Reemployment of Retired Teachers

FOR the purpose of exempting from a certain offset of a retirement allowance certain retirees of the Teachers' Retirement System or the Teachers' Pension System who are employed by certain public schools; requiring the State Board of Education county boards of education to provide certain information to the State Retirement Agency; requiring the State Board of Education to adopt certain regulations; requiring the State Board of Education to provide certain information to the county boards of education; requiring the State Board of Education to submit a certain report reports to the Governor and the General Assembly in a certain manner on or before a certain date dates; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the reemployment of retired teachers.
