~~(C)~~ (E) IN ASSESSING AN ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY UNDER THIS SECTION, THE COMMISSION SHALL CONSIDER:

(1) THE NATURE, CIRCUMSTANCES, EXTENT, GRAVITY, AND NUMBER OF VIOLATIONS ~~WITHIN EACH VIOLATION FOR WHICH AN ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY MAY BE ASSESSED.~~

(2) THE DEGREE OF CULPABILITY OF THE VIOLATOR;

(3) PRIOR OFFENSES AND REPEATED VIOLATIONS OF THE VIOLATOR;  
AND

(4) ANY OTHER MATTER THAT THE COMMISSION CONSIDERS APPROPRIATE AND RELEVANT.

~~(D)~~ (F) AN ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE PAID INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1999.

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## CHAPTER 545

(Senate Bill 311)

AN ACT concerning

### State Commission on the Capital City

FOR the purpose of establishing the State Commission on the Capital City; providing for the membership of the Commission; providing for the appointment, tenure, and duties of members of the Commission; providing for the chairmanship of the Commission; providing for the meeting times of the Commission; authorizing the Commission to accept and give or spend certain moneys received from certain sources; and generally relating to the State Commission on the Capital City.

BY adding to

Article – State Government

Section 9–401 through 9–407, inclusive, to be under the new subtitle “Subtitle 4. Commission on the Capital City”
