

Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government

SUBTITLE 4. COMMISSION ON THE CAPITAL CITY.

9-401.

IN THIS SUBTITLE, "COMMISSION" MEANS THE STATE COMMISSION ON THE CAPITAL CITY.

9-402.

THERE IS A STATE COMMISSION ON THE CAPITAL CITY.

9-403.

(A) THE COMMISSION CONSISTS OF:

(1) ONE INDIVIDUAL APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR; AND

(2) AS EX OFFICIO MEMBERS:

(I) THE GOVERNOR;

(II) THE STATE SENATOR WHO REPRESENTS THE DISTRICT IN WHICH ANNAPOLIS IS LOCATED;

(III) THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY;

(IV) THE MAYOR OF ANNAPOLIS; AND

(V) THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE UNITED STATES NAVAL ACADEMY.

(B) (1) THE TERM OF THE APPOINTED MEMBER IS 4 YEARS.

(2) AT THE END OF A TERM, THE APPOINTED MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(3) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

9-404.

THE APPOINTED MEMBER SHALL SERVE AS CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMISSION.

9-405.

THE COMMISSION SHALL MEET AT A REGULAR TIME AND PLACE TO BE DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSION.
