

(10) URBAN RENEWAL; AND

(11) ANY OTHER COMMUNITY NEED OR PROJECT THAT THE COMMISSION BELIEVES MAY IMPROVE:

(I) THE FACILITIES AND DEVELOPMENT OF ANNAPOLIS AND ADJACENT AREAS; AND

(II) THE FACILITIES AND DEVELOPMENT OF ANY UNIT OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT.

(D) (1) A STUDY OR RECOMMENDATION OF THE COMMISSION IS ADVISORY ONLY.

(2) THE COMMISSION MAY NOT REQUIRE OR COMPEL THE ADOPTION OR IMPLEMENTATION OF ANY RECOMMENDATION.

9-407.

IN ADDITION TO ANY POWERS SET FORTH ELSEWHERE, THE COMMISSION:

(1) MAY ACCEPT MONEY FROM A PRIVATE OR PUBLIC AGENCY FOR USE IN CARRYING OUT THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE COMMISSION; AND

(2) FOR THAT PURPOSE, MAY GIVE THE MONEY TO A PRIVATE OR PUBLIC AGENCY OR OTHERWISE SPEND THE MONEY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1999.

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## CHAPTER 546

### (House Bill 270)

AN ACT concerning

#### State Commission on the Capital City

FOR the purpose of establishing the State Commission on the Capital City; providing for the membership and duties of the Commission; providing for the appointment, ~~tenure, and duties of members~~ and tenure of a certain member of the Commission; providing for the chairmanship of the Commission; providing for the meeting times of the Commission; authorizing the Commission to accept and give or spend certain moneys received from certain sources; and generally relating to the State Commission on the Capital City.

Article - State Government

Section 9-401 through 9-407, inclusive, to be under the new subtitle "Subtitle 4. Commission on the Capital City"
