IN THIS SUBTITLE, "COMMISSION" MEANS THE STATE COMMISSION ON THE CAPITAL CITY.

THERE IS A STATE COMMISSION ON THE CAPITAL CITY. 9-403.

  - (1) ONE INDIVIDUAL APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR; AND
  - (2) AS EX OFFICIO MEMBERS:
    - (1) (2) THE GOVERNOR;
- (H) (3) THE STATE SENATOR WHO REPRESENTS THE LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT IN WHICH ANNAPOLIS IS LOCATED;
- (4) THE DELEGATES WHO REPRESENT THE LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT IN WHICH ANNAPOLIS IS LOCATED;
  - (HI) (5) THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY;
  - (HV) (6) THE MAYOR OF ANNAPOLIS; AND
- $rac{\langle V \rangle}{\langle T \rangle}$  THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE UNITED STATES NAVAL ACADEMY.
  - (B) (1) THE TERM OF THE APPOINTED MEMBER IS 4 YEARS.
- (2) AT THE END OF A TERM, THE APPOINTED MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (3) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

THE APPOINTED MEMBER SHALL SERVE AS CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMISSION.
