- (B) WITH RESPECT TO PERSONAL LINES AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE, THE AN INDEPENDENT AGENT, WHO DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY HAS AN OWNERSHIP INTEREST IN A PREMIUM FINANCE COMPANY, SHALL PROVIDE A DISCLOSURE TO BE SIGNED BY THE INSURED COMPARING THE COSTS AND TERMS OF PREMIUM FINANCING WITH THE INSURER'S ALTERNATIVE PAYMENT PLAN.
- (C) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO LIFE INSURANCE OR HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGES, EXCEPT THOSE COVERAGES DESCRIBED IN § 20 504 OF THIS ARTICLE.
