- (2) The Commission-has the implied and incidental powers needed or proper to carry out its functions under this article.
  - (e) The powers of the Commission shall be construed liberally.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1999.

## **CHAPTER 574**

(Senate Bill 569)

AN ACT concerning

## Natural Resources - Marine Sanitation

FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Natural Resources to survey certain waters and vessels for certain purposes by a certain date using certain criteria; requiring the Department to identify certain sensitive waters of the State by a certain date using certain criteria; requiring the Department to take certain steps to ensure that certain facilities relating to marine sanitation are reasonably available for use in certain areas; requiring a certain report by a certain date; requiring the Department to consult with the Department of the Environment on certain matters concerning the identification of sensitive waters; requiring the Department of Natural Resources to make certain recommendations to the Department of the Environment under certain circumstances; and generally relating to marine sanitation and waters of the State.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
