THIS SUBTITLE MAY BE CITED AS THE MARYLAND AFTER-SCHOOL OPPORTUNITY ACT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Governor shall include \$10 million in the fiscal year 2001 State budget for the Maryland After-School Opportunity Fund established under this Act, and that such funds shall be in addition to funds provided for child care and after-school programs in the fiscal year 2000 budget.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Executive Committee of the Advisory Board on After-School Opportunity Programs shall develop, in consultation with the Advisory Board, the first comprehensive plan of after-school opportunity programs, as specified in this Act, no later than December 15, 1999.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1999.

## Education - Maryland After-School Opportunity Act

FOR the purpose of providing for the Maryland After-School Opportunity Act; creating the Maryland After-School Opportunity Fund Program; requiring the Governor to include certain amounts in the annual State budget for the Fund Program for a certain fiscal year; requiring the Department of Education Human Resources to administer the Fund, adopt; establishing a certain Advisory Board and a certain Executive Committee in the Program; requiring the Executive Committee to adopt certain regulations and standards governing the Maryland After-School Opportunity Fund Program, and select a certain intermediary to make grants from the Fund to certain applicants, prepare certain comprehensive plans, and submit certain reports under certain circumstances; requiring the intermediary Executive Committee to use certain criteria in selecting grant recipients and to provide certain assistance to after school programs under the Program; and generally relating to the establishment of the Maryland After-School Opportunity Act and the creation of the Maryland After-School Opportunity Fund Program to assist parents in providing after-school care for children in the State.
