~~(6)~~ (6) ONE REPRESENTATIVE THE SPECIAL SECRETARY OF THE OFFICE OF FOR CHILDREN, YOUTH, AND FAMILIES DESIGNATED BY THE GOVERNOR OR THE SPECIAL SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE;

~~(7)~~ (7) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DESIGNATED BY THE GOVERNOR; AND

~~(8)~~ (8) EIGHT TWELVE FIFTEEN INDIVIDUALS SERVING 2-YEAR TERMS, TO BE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR, AS FOLLOWS:

(I) TWO MEMBERS WHO REPRESENT THE CHILDREN'S ADVOCACY COMMUNITY AND ARE NOT EMPLOYED BY AN ORGANIZATION THAT IS OR MAY BE A RECIPIENT OF MONEY FROM THE FUND;

(II) TWO MEMBERS WHO REPRESENT THE INTERESTS OF THE AFTER-SCHOOL PROVIDER COMMUNITY WHO REPRESENT PROVIDERS NOT INCLUDED IN ITEMS (VI) AND (VII) OF THIS SUBSECTION;

(III) TWO MEMBERS WHO ARE PARENTS OF STUDENTS ENROLLED IN THE STATE IN KINDERGARTEN THROUGH GRADE 12; AND

(IV) TWO MEMBERS WHO ARE STUDENTS ENROLLED IN THE STATE IN GRADES 6 THROUGH 12;

(V) ONE TEACHER WHO IS WORKING IN A SCHOOL IN THE STATE;

(VI) ONE MEMBER WHO IS A REGISTERED FAMILY CHILD CARE PROVIDER WHO SERVES SCHOOL AGE CHILDREN;
