(VII) ONE MEMBER WHO IS A STAFF MEMBER OF A LICENSED CHILD CARE CENTER THAT WHO SERVES SCHOOL AGE CHILDREN: AND

(VIII) ONE MEMBER OF A LOCAL MANAGEMENT BOARD;

- (IX) ONE MEMBER OF A LOCAL BOARD OF EDUCATION:
- (X) ONE MEMBER WHO IS A PROFESSIONAL IN THE FIELD OF RECREATION AND PARKS THAT DELIVERS LICENSED OR REGULATED CHILD CARE PROGRAMS; AND
- (XI) ONE MEMBER WHO REPRESENTS THE CONCERNS OF DEVELOPMENTALLY DISABLED CHILDREN.
- (C) THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE SHALL-SELECT A CHAIR TO SERVE FOR A TERM OF 2 YEARS.
  - (C) (1) THERE IS AN EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE ADVISORY BOARD.
- (2) THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING INDIVIDUALS:
  - (I) THE GOVERNOR OR THE GOVERNOR'S DESIGNEE;
- (II) THE SECRETARY OF HUMAN RESOURCES OR THE SECRETARYS
  DESIGNEE;
- (III) THE SECRETARY OF EDUCATION OR THE SECRETARYS STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS OR THE SUPERINTENDENT'S DESIGNEE;
- (IV) THE SECRETARY OF JUVENILE JUSTICE OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE; AND
- (VI) THE SPECIAL SECRETARY OF THE OFFICE FOR CHILDREN, YOUTH, AND FAMILIES OR THE SPECIAL SECRETARYS DESIGNEE.
- (D) (1) THE GOVERNOR SHALL SERVE AS THE CHAIR OF THE ADVISORY BOARD AND OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.
- (2) THE GOVERNOR MAY DESIGNATE THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OR ONE OF THE SECRETARIES SERVING ON THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE AND THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE TO ACT AS CHAIR IN THE GOVERNOR'S ABSENCE.
