

Board and requiring SHA to provide staff support to the Board; authorizing certain persons to appeal certain ~~access~~ decisions to the Board; requiring the Board to take certain actions in relation to the appeal; specifying certain substantive and procedural requirements; providing that certain decisions of the Board are binding on the SHA, but subject to approval of the Board of Public Works; and generally relating to a process under which certain property owners may seek a right of access to State highways.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

8-310.

(A) IN THIS SECTION, "BOARD" MEANS THE STATE HIGHWAY ACCESS VALUATION BOARD.

(B) (1) THE SECRETARY SHALL ESTABLISH A STATE HIGHWAY ACCESS VALUATION BOARD IN THE ADMINISTRATION.

(2) THE BOARD SHALL CONSIST OF:

(I) THE ADMINISTRATOR OR THE ADMINISTRATOR'S DESIGNEE;

(II) THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF PLANNING OR THE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE; AND

(III) THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE.

(3) THE ADMINISTRATOR OR THE ADMINISTRATOR'S DESIGNEE SHALL SERVE AS CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD.

(4) THE BOARD SHALL DETERMINE THE TIMES AND LOCATIONS OF ITS MEETINGS AND SHALL CONDUCT BUSINESS IN ACCORDANCE WITH PROCEDURES ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD.

(5) A MEMBER OF THE BOARD:

(I) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION AS A MEMBER OF THE BOARD; BUT

(II) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(6) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL PROVIDE STAFF TO THE BOARD.
