CHAPTER 598

(Senate Bill 737)

AN ACT concerning

Hunting - Complimentary Licenses

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Natural Resources to issue annually a complimentary hunting license to an official or enforcement officer of the game and fish management agency of another state under certain circumstances; and generally relating to complimentary hunting licenses.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

10-303.

(a) The Department annually may issue a complimentary hunter's license to the President of the United States, the governor of any state, any Maryland resident who certifies that the resident is a former prisoner of war or 100% service connected disabled American veteran, OR AN OFFICIAL OR AN ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OF THE GAME AND FISH MANAGEMENT AGENCY OF ANOTHER STATE WHICH RECIPROCALLY OFFERS COMPLIMENTARY HUNTING LICENSES. A complimentary license is not transferable and shall be issued on forms designated by the Department.
