(b) The Commission may:

- (1) Make contracts or other legal agreements or arrangements necessary or incidental to the exercise of its powers and performance of its duties;
- (2) Sue and be sued;
- (3) Implead and be impleaded;
- (4) Complain and defend in all courts [of law];
- (5) Adopt and alter an official seal; and
- (6) Adopt bylaws, rules and guidelines to regulate its affairs and the conduct of its business.

(c) Each soil conservation district may recommend a fee system to cover the cost of reviewing the grading and sediment control plans. Subject to § 8-311 of the Agriculture Article, any recommended fee shall take effect upon enactment by the local governing body. Any fees collected pursuant to this fee system shall be supplementary to county and State funds and may not [(i)] (1) be used to reduce county or State funds, and [(ii)] (2) exceed the cost of reviewing the plans.
