AN ACT concerning

Environment - Kent Island Citizens Oversight Committee

FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor to appoint a Kent Island Citizens Oversight Committee; requiring the Governor to determine the terms and qualifications of members of the Oversight Committee; requiring the Oversight
