- (2) "SUPERVISION" INCLUDES PHYSICIAN OVERSIGHT OF AND ACCEPTANCE OF DIRECT RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE PATIENT SERVICES AND CARE RENDERED BY A PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT, INCLUDING CONTINUOUS AVAILABILITY TO THE PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT IN PERSON, THROUGH WRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS, OR BY ELECTRONIC MEANS.
