- (8) ONE MEMBER OF PRIVATE INDUSTRY WHO SHALL REPRESENT INTERNET SERVICE PROVIDERS, APPOINTED BY THE COVERNOR:
- (9) TWO MEMBERS OF PRIVATE INDUSTRY WHO SHALL REPRESENT BUSINESSES, OTHER THAN INTERNET SERVICE PROVIDERS, THAT ENGAGE IN INTERNET COMMERCE. APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR:
- (10) THREE REPRESENTATIVES FOR INTERNET USERS AND INTERNET CONSUMERS. APPOINTED BY THE COVERNOR:
- (11) THREE REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE HEALTH CARE INDUSTRY, APPOINTED BY THE COVERNOR; AND
- (12) ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE GENERAL PUBLIC WHO HAS SIGNIFICANT INTERNET AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY EXPERIENCE, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR
 - (C) THE TERM OF AN APPOINTED MEMBER IS 3 YEARS.
- (D) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (E) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BECUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
 - (F) THE COVERNOR MAY REMOVE A MEMBER FOR:
 - (1) INCOMPETENCE OR MISCONDUCT: OR
 - (2) FAILURE TO RECULARLY ATTEND COMMISSION MEETINGS.
- (G) FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS, THE COMMISSION ANNUALLY SHALL ELECT
- (H) THE MANNER OF ELECTION OF OFFICERS SHALL BE AS THE COMMISSION DETERMINES.
- (I) THE CHAIRMAN MAY ESTABLISH SUBCOMMITTEES TO ASSIST IN THE WORK OF THE COMMISSION.
 - (J) A QUORUM OF THE COMMISSION IS 11 MEMBERS.
- (K) THE COMMISSION SHALL DETERMINE THE TIMES AND PLACES OF ITS MEETINGS.
 - (L) A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION:
- (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION FOR DUTIES PERFORMED AS A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION; BUT
- (2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
