- (III) THREE SHALL BE MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES, APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE:
- (IV) THREE SHALL BE MEMBERS OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;
- (V) ONE SHALL BE A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE JUDICIAL BRANCH, APPOINTED BY THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE COURT OF APPEALS:
- £(ii) seven shall be members of the public with significant information technology experience; and
- (iii) (VI) one shall be a representative of the Maryland Association of Community Colleges; AND
- (IV) ONE SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;
- (V) ONE SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE MARYLAND HOUSE OF DELEGATES, APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE; AND
- (VI) ONE SHALL BE A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE JUDICIAL BRANCH, APPOINTED BY THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE COURT OF APPEALS.
- (VII) TWELVE SHALL BE MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC, APPOINTED BY THE COVERNOR, WITH SIGNIFICANT-INFORMATION-TECHNOLOGY EXPERIENCE, INCLUDING:
- <u>A REPRESENTATIVE FROM PRIVATE INDUSTRY WHO</u>
  REPRESENTS INTERNET SERVICE PROVIDERS:
- 2. FOUR INDIVIDUALS FROM PRIVATE INDUSTRY WHO REPRESENT BUSINESSES, OTHER THAN INTERNET SERVICE PROVIDERS, THAT ENCAGE IN INTERNET COMMERCE OR OTHER RETAIL OR FINANCIAL SERVICES ACTIVITIES;
- 3: TWO INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE HEALTH CARE INDUSTRY;
  - 4. A REPRESENTATIVE OF A PUBLIC LIBRARY, AND
- $\underline{\underline{5}}$  FOUR INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE INTERNET USERS AND CONSUMERS.
- (b) The Governor shall appoint the public members with the advice and consent of the Senate.
- (c) The term of a public member is 3 years and until a successor is appointed by the Governor.
- (d) Public members may be reappointed, but may not serve more than two consecutive terms.
