Except for a cemetery in which no burials have taken place within the previous 5 years, a bona fide religious, nonprofit cemetery that is exempt under § 5-102 of this title from the registration and permitting requirements of this title shall file with the Office, once every 2 years, a statement that includes:

(1) the name and address of the cemetery;

(2) the name and address of the religious organization that owns and operates the cemetery; and

(3) the name and address of the individual who is responsible for the oversight of the cemetery.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1999.

AN ACT concerning

**Motor Vehicle Liability Insurance - Minimum Benefits of Security -
Maximum Amounts Payable from MAIF - Property Damage Claims**

FOR the purpose of altering the maximum amount payable from the Maryland Automobile Insurance Fund (MAIF) for unsatisfied claims for property damage under certain circumstances; altering the minimum benefits of security for property damage that a motor vehicle liability insurance policy must provide; and generally relating to minimum benefits of security in motor vehicle liability insurance and maximum amounts payable from MAIF for property damage claims.
