

CHAPTER 690

(House Bill 1155)

AN ACT concerning

Delegate Scholarships - Use at Out-of-State Institutions - Disabled Applicants

FOR the purpose of establishing that disabled applicants may use a Delegate Scholarship at certain institutions outside the State under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the use of a Delegate Scholarship at an institution outside the State.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

18-501.

(a) There is a program of Delegate Scholarships in this State that are awarded under this subtitle.

(b) A scholarship awarded under this subtitle may be used at:

(1) An eligible institution for a program of undergraduate, graduate, or professional studies;

(2) An accredited undergraduate, graduate, or professional institution outside the State, if:

(I) [the] THE applicant will be studying in an academic area that is not available in this State; OR

(II) 1. THE APPLICANT IS DISABLED;

2. THE APPLICANT WILL BE STUDYING AT AN INSTITUTION OUTSIDE THE STATE THAT MAKES SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR DISABLED STUDENTS; AND

3. COMPARABLE SPECIAL PROVISIONS ARE NOT AVAILABLE TO THAT STUDENT AT AN INSTITUTION IN THE STATE; and
