- (ii) Use the individual's official authority for the purpose of influencing or affecting the result of an election; or
- (iii) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, take an active part in political management or a political campaign related to any candidate or any matter that is subject to an election under this article.
- (2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1)(iii) of this subsection, except while performing official duties on election day, an election judge may engage in the activities of a political campaign, other than serving as a campaign manager for a candidate or as the treasurer for a candidate or committee.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1999.

(House Bill 496)

## Assisted Suicide - Prohibition

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from assisting another person's suicide or suicide attempt; excepting certain medical situations and procedures; allowing certain persons with standing to seek civil or injunctive relief, and reasonable attorney's fees, from a violator of this Act; allowing certain persons with standing to seek certain civil penalties; allowing the relevant licensing board to take administrative action against a violator of this Act; establishing certain penalties for a violation of this Act; making provisions of this Act severable; defining certain terms; and generally relating to assisted suicide.
