- (1) Is not inconsistent with the State health plan or any institution-specific plan;
- (2) Will result in the delivery of more efficient and effective hospital services; and
 - (3) Is in the public interest.
- (b) Notwithstanding the fact that a merger or consolidation or the joint ownership and operation of major medical equipment may limit free economic competition, a hospital may engage in a merger or consolidation or the joint ownership of major medical equipment that has been approved by the Commission under this section.

19-131. RESERVED

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- (A) THERE IS AN ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON LONG TERM CARE IN THE COMMISSION:
- (B) THE PURPOSE OF THE COMMITTEE IS TO ADVISE AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE COMMISSION ON THE DELIVERY OF LONG TERM CARE IN MARYLAND'S HEALTH CARE SYSTEM.
- (C) (1) THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE SHALL CONSIST OF NINE MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE COVERNOR
 - (2) OF THE NINE MEMBERS:
- (I) THREE SHALL REPRESENT ENTITIES PROVIDING LONG TERM CARE, AT LEAST TWO OF WHICH SHALL REPRESENT COMPREHENSIVE CARE FACILITIES;
 - (H) ONE SHALL REPRESENT AN ASSISTED LIVING FACILITY:
- (HI) ONE SHALL BE A REGISTERED NURSE WITH TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE IN GERIATRIC MEDICINE;
- (IV) ONE SHALL BE A LICENSED PHYSICIAN WITH TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE IN GERIATRIC MEDICINE;
 - (V) ONE SHALL REPRESENT THE DEPARTMENT OF ACINC;
- (VI) ONE SHALL REPRESENT THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYCIENE; AND

(VII) ONE SHALL BE A PUBLIC MEMBER.

- (1) THE COVERNOR SHALL APPOINT A CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE.
- (2) THE COMMITTEE SHALL DETERMINE THE TIMES AND PLACES OF ITS MEETINGS.
