  - (ii) the greater of:
- 1. the number of years of the member's creditable service on or before June 30, 1998 multiplied by 1.2% of the member's average final compensation; or
- 2. the number of years of the member's creditable service on or before June 30, 1998 multiplied by:
- A. 0.8% of the member's average final compensation that is not in excess of the Social Security integration level; and
- $$\rm B.~1.5\%$  of the member's average final compensation that exceeds the Social Security integration level.
