[(a)] There is a State Fisheries Management and Protection Fund in the Department. Any money received from any fish and fisheries license, stamp, permit, or application fee as provided in this title, unless otherwise provided shall be credited to the Fund and used only for the scientific investigation, protection, propagation, and management of nontidal finfish.

[(b) The clerks of the courts shall transmit to the Department on the first day of each month any money received by them for sport fishing licenses and stamps. The Department shall account for these funds to the Treasurer who then shall credit amounts received to the State Fisheries Management and Protection Fund. The Treasurer shall pay out funds on the warrant of the Comptroller upon requisition of the Department.]

4-11A-19.

(a) Any person desiring to sell live bait in Montgomery, Frederick, or Washington County shall apply to [the clerk of the circuit court for the county] A PERSON DESIGNATED BY THE DEPARTMENT for a live bait dealer's license. The application shall be in the form the Department prescribes, and contain an affidavit signed by the applicant that he is a resident of the county. Upon payment by the applicant of an annual fee of \$10.50, the [clerk of the circuit court] DESIGNATED PERSON may issue a license supplied by the Department to the [clerk] DESIGNATED PERSON. As compensation for each bait dealer's license issued, the [clerk of the circuit court] DESIGNATED PERSON shall retain 50 cents. Any money collected for license fees during a month shall be forwarded to the Department on the first day of each succeeding month. The Department shall account for the money to the State Treasurer.

10-209.

[(a)] There is a State Wildlife Management and Protection Fund in the Department. Any money accruing to the Fund from any license, stamp, application, or permit fee provided in this title shall be credited, unless otherwise provided, to this Fund and used only for the scientific investigation, protection, propagation, and management of wildlife.

[(b) The clerks of the courts shall transmit to the Department on the first day of each month all moneys received by the clerks for hunting licenses and stamps. The Department shall account for these funds to the Treasurer who then shall credit amounts received to the State Wildlife Management and Protection Fund. The Treasurer shall pay out funds on the warrant of the Comptroller upon requisition of the Department.]

10-301.

(c) A person may apply for a hunter's license [to the clerk of the circuit court for any county or] to any person designated by the Department. The application shall be on a form the Department prepares and supplies. The applicant shall fill out, sign, and submit the application to the [court clerk or] person designated to issue the hunter's license. A person may apply by mail.
