SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## SUBTITLE 21. MARYLAND TEACHER SCHOLARSHIPS.

- (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (B) "ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION" MEANS AN INSTITUTION AS DEFINED BY § 18 103
  OF THIS TITLE A PRIVATE OR PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THIS
  STATE THAT POSSESSES A CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL FROM THE MARYLAND
  HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION.
- (C) (1) "SERVICE OBLIGATION" MEANS TO TEACH FULL TIME IN THE STATE AS A CERTIFIED TEACHER IN A MARYLAND <u>PUBLIC</u> PUBLIC ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY SCHOOL.
- (2) "SERVICE OBLIGATION" DOES NOT MEAN EMPLOYMENT AS TEACHING ASSISTANTS, PROVISIONAL CERTIFICATE TEACHING POSITIONS, VOLUNTEER SERVICE, PAID FELLOWSHIPS, OR INTERNSHIPS.
- (D) "ADMINISTRATION" MEANS THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP ADMINISTRATION AS DEFINED IN  $\S$  18–101(B) OF THIS TITLE.
