

administrative agency within seven days after the court has ordered the rent paid into an administrative agency. If the tenant fails to pay rent due within this period, or as it comes due, the court, on motion of the landlord, shall give judgment in favor of the landlord and issue a warrant for possession in accordance with the provisions of § 8-401(c) and (d).

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1999.

Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 577.

This bill requires the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to establish in regulations as a prospective rate the reasonable cost to a federally qualified health center of providing services to Medicaid enrollees.

House Bill 660, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on April 27, 1999, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 577.

AN ACT concerning

Medical Assistance Program - Federally Qualified Health Centers

FOR the purpose of ~~specifying a certain time and methodology for the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene and a federally qualified health center to determine certain costs of the center~~ requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, in consultation with the Federally Qualified Health Centers, to establish in regulation as a prospective rate the reasonable cost to a federally qualified health center in providing services to enrollees under the State Medical Assistance Program; requiring certain federally qualified health centers to provide the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene with certain data and reports to assist the Department in making a certain calculation; authorizing a certain federally qualified health center at certain times to make a request for the Department to review certain payments made to the center; establishing the effective date for certain adjustments; requiring the Department, in
