(A) THERE IS A MARYLAND COMPETITIVE ADVANTAGE FINANCING FUND IN THE DEPARTMENT.

- (B) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR THE DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION OF SMALL AND ECONOMICALLY DISADVANTACED INDIVIDUALS BUSINESSES IN THE STATE.
  - (C) (1) THE SECRETARY SHALL MANAGE AND ADMINISTER THE FUND.
- (2) THE SECRETARY MAY DELEGATE THE AUTHORITY TO MAKE FINANCING DECISIONS TO ANY BOARD OR AUTHORITY IN THE DEPARTMENT.
- (D) (1) THE FUND IS A CONTINUING, NONLAPSING FUND WHICH IS NOT SUBJECT TO  $\S$  7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.
- $\ \,$  (2) The treasurer shall separately hold and the comptroller shall account for the fund.

  - (E) THE FUND MAY CONSIST OF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
    - (1) MONEYS APPROPRIATED BY THE STATE TO THE FUND.

- (5) APPLICATION OR OTHER FEES PAID TO THE PROGRAM IN CONNECTION WITH THE PROCESSING OF REQUESTS FOR ASSISTANCE; AND
- (6) ANY OTHER MONEYS MADE AVAILABLE TO THE FUND. 5–1303.
