SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Business Occupations and Professions

15-101.

- (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (b) "Board" means the State Board for Professional Land Surveyors.
- (d) (1) "License" means, unless the context requires otherwise, a license issued by the Board to practice:
 - (i) land surveying; or
 - (ii) property line surveying.
- (2) "License" includes, unless the context requires otherwise:
 - (i) a license to practice land surveying;
 - (ii) a license to practice property line surveying;
 - (iii) a limited license issued under § 15-316 of this title; and
 - (iv) a temporary license issued under § 15-317 of this title.

15-314.

(a) Unless a license is renewed for a 2-year term as provided in this section, the license expires on the first June 30 that comes:

- (1) after the effective date of the license; and
 - (2) in an odd-numbered year.
- (b) (1) At least 1 month before a license expires, the Board shall mail to the licensee, at the last known address of the licensee:
- (i) a renewal application form; and
 - (ii) a notice that states:
