(A) THE COUNCIL CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS:

- (1) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR;
 - (2) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OR THE ATTORNEY GENERAL'S DESIGNEE;
 - (3) THE SECRETARY OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE;
 - (4) A REPRESENTATIVE OF EACH CRIME LABORATORY, APPOINTED BY THE HEAD OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY THAT OPERATES THE LABORATORY;
 - (5) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE STATE'S ATTORNEYS' ASSOCIATION, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR; AND
 - (6) THE PUBLIC DEFENDER OR THE PUBLIC DEFENDER'S DESIGNEE;

~~(6) (7) A JUDGE OF A CIRCUIT COURT, APPOINTED BY THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE COURT OF APPEALS.~~

~~(B) (1) EXCEPT FOR THE TERMS OF THE INITIALLY APPOINTED MEMBERS, THE TERM OF AN APPOINTED MEMBER IS 4 YEARS.~~

~~(2) THE TERMS OF APPOINTED MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR THE INITIAL MEMBERS ON OCTOBER 1, 1990.~~

~~(3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.~~

~~(4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.~~

(A) THE COUNCIL ANNUALLY SHALL ELECT A CHAIRMAN, VICE-CHAIRMAN, AND OTHER OFFICERS FROM AMONG THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL.

(B) THE MANNER OF ELECTING OFFICERS SHALL BE AS THE COUNCIL DETERMINES.

18-405.

(A) A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL THEN SERVING IS A QUORUM.

(B) THE COUNCIL SHALL MEET AT LEAST TWICE A YEAR, AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT THE COUNCIL DETERMINES.
