

3-216. CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS — POWER OF ARREST.

(A) DESIGNATION BY COMMISSIONER.

THE COMMISSIONER SHALL DESIGNATE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS EMPLOYED IN EACH CORRECTIONAL FACILITY IN THE DIVISION WHO HAVE THE POWER TO MAKE ARRESTS UNDER ARTICLE 27, § 594B OF THE CODE.

(B) QUALIFICATIONS.

A CORRECTIONAL OFFICER WHO IS AUTHORIZED TO MAKE ARRESTS UNDER ARTICLE 27, § 594B OF THE CODE SHALL:

(1) MEET THE MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED BY THE MARYLAND POLICE TRAINING COMMISSION; AND

(2) COMPLETE SATISFACTORILY THE TRAINING PRESCRIBED BY THE MARYLAND POLICE TRAINING COMMISSION.

3-217. PERFORMANCE BONDS.

(A) WHEN REQUIRED.

(1) THE GOVERNOR MAY REQUIRE THE COMMISSIONER TO EXECUTE A SURETY BOND IN AN AMOUNT THAT THE GOVERNOR ESTABLISHES.

(2) THE COMMISSIONER MAY REQUIRE ANY OFFICER OR OTHER EMPLOYEE OF THE DIVISION TO EXECUTE A SURETY BOND IN THE AMOUNT THAT THE COMMISSIONER, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE COMPTROLLER, ESTABLISHES.

(3) THE BOND SHALL BE CONDITIONED ON THE INDIVIDUAL FAITHFULLY PERFORMING THE DUTIES OF OFFICE AND ACCOUNTING FOR ALL FUNDS OFFICIALLY RECEIVED.

(B) ISSUANCE.

(1) THE SURETY BOND FOR THE COMMISSIONER SHALL BE ISSUED BY A CORPORATE SURETY APPROVED BY THE GOVERNOR.

(2) THE SURETY BOND FOR ANY OFFICER OR OTHER EMPLOYEE OF THE DIVISION SHALL BE ISSUED BY A CORPORATE SURETY APPROVED BY THE COMMISSIONER AND THE COMPTROLLER.
