## Annexation Resolution No. 1-97

A RESOLUTION of the City Council of the City of Fruitland proposing the annexation to the City of Fruitland of a certain area of land situated contiguous to and binding upon the Northeasterly Corporate Limits of the City of Fruitland, popularly known as the "Cedar Lane/Hanna Annexation" bounded on the Northeast by Tony Tank Creek, on the East by the lands of the Perdue Estate, on the South by lands of Masten Lumber Supply and binding upon Cedar Lane; and bounded on the West by the Corporate Limits of the City of Fruitland; and including the lands owned by Consolidated Rail Corporation and a portion of U.S. Route 13. (2 parcels – 36.86 acres of land, more or less)
