- (4) create the <u>non-merit</u> position of Fire Administrator to help formulate and enforce the policies of the Commission and other applicable laws and regulations;
- (5) create the <u>non-merit</u> positions of [[Career]] Chief <u>of the Division of Fire and Rescue Services</u> and [[Volunteer]] Chief <u>of the Division of Volunteer Fire and Rescue Services</u> [[to have day to day command of career merit system employees and volunteers, respectively]], under the direction of the [[Commission as implemented by the]] Fire Administrator; and
- (6) <u>update, clarify, and</u> generally amend County law involving the provision of fire and rescue services.
