AN ACT concerning

**Telecommunications Franchises for the Use of Public Property and Public Rights-of-way in the County**

For the purpose of establishing procedures for the granting of franchises for the use of public property and/or public rights-of-way for telecommunications systems; preserving the County's rights in and control over public property and public rights-of-way used to provide telecommunications service; providing for the payment of compensation and other valuable consideration by telecommunications franchisees; authorizing executive regulations to implement, enforce, and administer this Division; and, generally providing for the franchising of telecommunications systems in the County.

BY adding:
