

(I) ADVISE STATE USE INDUSTRIES ON ITS SPECIFIC PROPOSALS TO ESTABLISH NEW INDUSTRIES AND IMPROVE THE QUALITY AND QUANTITY OF JOB TRAINING PROGRAMS; AND

(II) RECOMMEND THE ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF INDUSTRIAL PLANTS AND SERVICE CENTERS TO BE USED FOR IMPLEMENTING THE PROGRAMS DEVELOPED BY THE COMMISSIONER AND GENERAL MANAGER UNDER § 3-511 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(2) STATE USE INDUSTRIES SHALL OPERATE INDUSTRIAL PLANTS AND SERVICE CENTERS RECOMMENDED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)(II) OF THIS SUBSECTION PRIMARILY WITH INMATES IN A MANNER THAT BENEFITS THE STATE AND THE TRAINING OF INMATES BY PRODUCING GOODS OR PROVIDING SERVICES THAT ARE PRACTICAL AND ADAPTABLE FOR A PRISON INDUSTRY.

(B) OPERATIONS.

THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE SHALL:

(1) REVIEW THE OPERATION OF STATE USE INDUSTRIES' PROGRAMS TO DETERMINE WHETHER THERE IS UNDUE COMPETITION WITH PRIVATE ENTERPRISE AND RECOMMEND NECESSARY ADJUSTMENTS TO PREVENT UNDUE COMPETITION;

(2) REVIEW THE STANDARDS FOR GOODS AND SERVICES AND THE PRICING SCHEDULES AS RECOMMENDED BY THE GENERAL MANAGER; AND

(3) REVIEW THE OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY RECORD OF STATE USE INDUSTRIES' PROGRAMS.

(C) INMATES.

THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE SHALL:

(1) REVIEW THE SUCCESS OF STATE USE INDUSTRIES IN:

(I) MEETING THE EMPLOYABILITY DEVELOPMENT NEEDS OF INMATES; AND

(II) COORDINATING WORK PROGRAMS WITH OTHER REHABILITATIVE PROGRAMS; AND

(2) SOLICIT AND REVIEW INFORMATION PERTAINING TO CONCERNS OF PARTICIPATING INMATES.

(D) NAME CHANGE.

THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE MAY CHANGE THE NAME OF STATE USE INDUSTRIES TO A NAME MORE APPROPRIATE FOR A JOB TRAINING ORGANIZATION.
