

THE SECRETARY MAY AUTHORIZE THE HOUSING IN THE BALTIMORE CITY DETENTION CENTER OF ANY INMATE HELD IN CUSTODY UNDER ANY UNIT IN THE DEPARTMENT.

5-402. WARDEN.

(A) APPOINTMENT.

WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE SECRETARY, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL APPOINT A WARDEN OF THE BALTIMORE CITY DETENTION CENTER.

(B) TENURE.

THE WARDEN SERVES AT THE PLEASURE OF THE COMMISSIONER.

(C) DUTIES.

SUBJECT TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE COMMISSIONER AND THE SECRETARY, THE WARDEN IS IN CHARGE OF THE BALTIMORE CITY DETENTION CENTER.

5-403. ASSISTANT WARDENS.

(A) APPOINTMENT.

THE COMMISSIONER MAY APPOINT ASSISTANT WARDENS FOR THE BALTIMORE CITY DETENTION CENTER AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

AN ASSISTANT WARDEN SERVES AT THE PLEASURE OF THE COMMISSIONER.
