8-108. SAME — OFFICERS.

THE COMMISSION SHALL ELECT ANNUALLY A CHAIRPERSON AND VICE CHAIRPERSON FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS.

The former reference to the "initial organizational meeting and thereafter" is deleted as obsolete.

The references to "chairperson" and "vice chairperson" are substituted for the former references to "chairman" and "vice-chairman", respectively, because SG § 2-1238 requires the use of words that are neutral as to gender to the extent practicable.

8-109. SAME — QUORUM; MEETINGS; COMPENSATION.

(A) QUORUM.

A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION IS A QUORUM.

(B) MEETINGS.

THE COMMISSION SHALL MEET AT THE TIMES DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSION OR ITS CHAIRPERSON.

(C) COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES.

A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION:

- (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION FOR SERVICE ON THE COMMISSION; BUT
- (2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
