- (2) THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF PAROLE AND PROBATION;
- (3) THE COMMISSIONER OF CORRECTION;
- (4) THE PRESIDENT OF THE MARYLAND CORRECTIONAL ADMINISTRATORS ASSOCIATION:
 - (5) THE PRESIDENT OF THE MARYLAND SHERIFFS ASSOCIATION:
- (6) THE PRESIDENT OF THE MARYLAND CRIMINAL JUSTICE ASSOCIATION:
- (7) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF PRISONS, DESIGNATED BY ITS DIRECTOR;
 - (8) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OF THE STATE;
- (9) THE PRESIDENT OF A UNIVERSITY OR COLLEGE IN THE STATE WITH A CORRECTIONAL EDUCATION CURRICULUM, APPOINTED BY THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION: AND
- (10) THREE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS OR OFFICIALS OF THE STATE APPOINTED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.
 - (B) CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS; TERMS; APPOINTMENT OF SUCCESSORS.
- (1) WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR, THE SECRETARY SHALL APPOINT THREE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS OR OFFICIALS TO BE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION.
- (2) THE THREE MEMBERS APPOINTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL REPRESENT DIFFERENT GEOGRAPHIC AREAS OF THE STATE.
- (3) THE TERM OF A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION IS 3 YEARS.
- (4) THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS WHO ARE APPOINTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION ON OCTOBER 1, 1999.
- (5) (I) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER WHO WAS APPOINTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (II) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
 - (C) DESIGNATION OF REPRESENTATIVES.

EXCEPT FOR THE THREE MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE SECRETARY UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION MAY SERVE PERSONALLY AT A COMMISSION MEETING OR DESIGNATE A REPRESENTATIVE FROM
