

INSTITUTION, THE DIVISION OF CORRECTION SHALL PROMPTLY NOTIFY THE MANAGING OFFICIAL OF THE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY IN WHICH THE INMATE IS CONFINED OF THE DETAINDER LODGED AGAINST THE INMATE AND OF THE UNTRIED INDICTMENT, INFORMATION, WARRANT, OR COMPLAINT ON WHICH IT IS BASED.

(B) DUTY TO INFORM INMATE.

WITHIN 15 DAYS AFTER RECEIVING NOTICE OF A DETAINDER AND THE UNTRIED INDICTMENT, INFORMATION, WARRANT, OR COMPLAINT ON WHICH IT IS BASED, THE MANAGING OFFICIAL HAVING IMMEDIATE SUPERVISION OVER THE INMATE SHALL INFORM THE INMATE IN WRITING:

(1) OF THE SOURCE AND CONTENTS OF THE DETAINDER LODGED AGAINST THE INMATE; AND

(2) OF THE INMATE'S RIGHT TO MAKE A REQUEST FOR FINAL DISPOSITION OF THE INDICTMENT, INFORMATION, WARRANT, OR COMPLAINT ON WHICH THE DETAINDER IS BASED.

(C) DISMISSAL OF INDICTMENT.

IF AN INMATE IS NOT INFORMED WITHIN 1 YEAR OF A DETAINDER LODGED AGAINST THE INMATE AND OF THE INMATE'S RIGHT TO MAKE A REQUEST FOR FINAL DISPOSITION OF THE INDICTMENT, INFORMATION, WARRANT, OR COMPLAINT ON WHICH THE DETAINDER IS BASED:

(1) THE COURT SHALL NO LONGER HAVE JURISDICTION OVER THE INDICTMENT, INFORMATION, WARRANT, OR COMPLAINT;

(2) THE UNTRIED INDICTMENT, INFORMATION, WARRANT, OR COMPLAINT SHALL HAVE NO FURTHER FORCE OR EFFECT; AND

(3) THE COURT SHALL ENTER AN ORDER DISMISSING THE UNTRIED INDICTMENT, INFORMATION, WARRANT, OR COMPLAINT WITHOUT PREJUDICE.

(D) DUTY TO FILE INMATE'S REQUEST FOR FINAL DISPOSITION.

(1) AN INMATE WHO HAS BEEN NOTIFIED OF A DETAINDER LODGED AGAINST THE INMATE MAY REQUEST THAT THE MANAGING OFFICIAL HAVING IMMEDIATE SUPERVISION OVER THE INMATE FILE THE INMATE'S REQUEST FOR FINAL DISPOSITION OF THE UNTRIED INDICTMENT, INFORMATION, WARRANT, OR COMPLAINT, ALONG WITH THE STATEMENT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.

(2) WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER RECEIPT OF AN INMATE'S REQUEST UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE MANAGING OFFICIAL HAVING CUSTODY OF THE INMATE SHALL FILE THE INMATE'S REQUEST FOR FINAL DISPOSITION AND THE STATEMENT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION WITH THE APPROPRIATE STATE'S ATTORNEY AND THE APPROPRIATE COURT.

(3) THE MANAGING OFFICIAL SHALL FILE THE INMATE'S REQUEST FOR FINAL DISPOSITION AND THE REQUIRED STATEMENT BY CERTIFIED MAIL, RETURN RECEIPT REQUESTED.
