(C) INSTITUTION.

"INSTITUTION" MEANS ANY PENAL OR CORRECTIONAL FACILITY, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO A FACILITY FOR THE MENTALLY ILL OR MENTALLY DEFECTIVE, IN WHICH INMATES MAY LAWFULLY BE CONFINED.

(F) STATE.

"STATE" MEANS A STATE OF THE UNITED STATES, THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, A TERRITORY OR POSSESSION OF THE UNITED STATES, THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, OR THE COMMONWEALTH OF PUERTO RICO.
