

IN THE SEPTEMBER PAYMENT, THE STATE SHALL COMPENSATE A COUNTY FOR A DISCREPANCY BETWEEN THE PAYMENTS MADE AND THE ACTUAL REQUIRED REIMBURSEMENT FOR THE PREVIOUS FISCAL YEAR.

(C) DUTY OF COMPTROLLER

WITHIN 5 DAYS AFTER THE COMPTROLLER RECEIVES A CERTIFICATION UNDER THIS SECTION FROM THE SECRETARY, THE COMPTROLLER SHALL DRAW A WARRANT ON THE TREASURER FOR THE AMOUNT DUE TO A COUNTY.

(D) DUTY OF TREASURER

THE TREASURER SHALL IMMEDIATELY PAY THE AMOUNT DUE TO THE COUNTY.

In subsections (b) and (c) of this section, the requirement that "the Secretary shall certify to the State Comptroller", which was in the introductory clause of former Art. 27, § 690(d)(3), is deleted to clarify that the certification requirement did not apply to former Art. 27, § 690(d)(3)(ii) and (iii), which are revised in subsections (b) and (c) of this section.

9-405. SAME -- MEDICAL EXPENSES.

AFTER EACH FISCAL YEAR THE STATE SHALL REIMBURSE A COUNTY FOR MEDICAL EXPENSES THAT EXCEED \$25,000 FOR EACH INMATE CONFINED IN A LOCAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITY, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE INMATE HAS BEEN SENTENCED.
