9-517. MAINTENANCE OF PARKS AND PUBLIC AREAS BY INMATES — SOMERSET COUNTY.

(A) IN GENERAL.

AT THE REQUEST OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SOMERSET COUNTY OR THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IN SOMERSET COUNTY, THE DIVISION OF CORRECTION SHALL SUPPLY INMATES, IF REASONABLY AVAILABLE, TO WORK ON PROJECTS TO DEVELOP, IMPROVE, AND MAINTAIN PUBLIC AREAS, PARKS, AND RECREATION AREAS IN THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION.
